The theoretical part

The date indicated in the registration system corresponds to the date of the examination. Please save the dates in your diary.

You will be given access to our e-learning platform as soon as our staff has validated your registration for the theoretical part. You will have access to this e-learning platform at any time and will be able to take the theoretical part at your convenience.

You must complete all the lectures of the e-learning which will be validated by the written examination (on site, not online).

The theoretical part is labelled with **EXAM** (green colour) in our registration system.

The practical part

LTK Module 1: the practical part is a block of three days in a row. Choose a block of three days in the registration system. The dates of the practical part are indicated in the registration system. Please save the dates in your diary.

LTK Module 20: the practical part consists of three separate days. You must register for three separate days that correspond to your species of interest. Note that one day may be split into two halfays.

If you are working with a single species, choose three days corresponding to that animal species. Please note that fish and amphibians are considered as "aquatic animals". In this case choose two fish days and one day amphibians.

The practical part is labelled with **PRACTICAL TRAINING** (blue colour) in our registration system.

If possible, complete the theoretical part before the practical part. This is often not possible for Module 20.

Important information for the theoretical part: our e-learning platform currently only offers theory in English and German languages. We plan a new version of the e-learning in cooperation with Resal with three languages (English, German and French).

VERY IMPORTANT : if you already had an education (for instance a FELASA accredited course abroad), please contact the authorities to ask for recognition of this education and indicate with yes at the registration form. The authorities will inform you about the part of the education you have to complete in one of our courses. Please indicate in remarks of the registration form for the corresponding part/s (theoretical and/or practical part) which topics you have to complete. If nothing is mentioned in remarks in the registration form, we consider that we complete the full part of the chosen session/s.

If the authorities ask you to complete only the theoretical part "ethics", "legislation" and "3Rs", please register only in the module EGA.
